- 1. Purchase of property at 4005 N Division
- 2. New church AC system installed
- 3. Preservation of our Stained Glass Windows 100% funded by contributions
- 4. New JFK boiler system installed original was nearly 60 yrs old
- 5. Upgraded entrance security around our church

*** Thanks to the generosity of our parishioners, we were able to apply \$87,740 in principle payments on our mortgage with Quad City Bank & Trust. To complete the projects listed above, the parish borrowed an additional \$100,000. The outstanding principle on the mortgage as of June 30, 2017 was only \$274,260.
