

Vision 20/20 Update

As many of you saw in last week's Catholic Messenger, the diocese is now moving forward with the regional listening sessions for Vision 20/20. Our Lady of Victory will be hosting one of these regional sessions where parishioners from Holy Family, St. Paul the Apostle and our parish will sit down and go through the same topics that we discussed at our parish listening session in October. After all of these regional listening sessions are completed, the diocese will summarize all of the feedback to form the discussions that will be happening at the Vision 20/20 convocation this summer at St. Ambrose University. The keynote speakers, break-out sessions, and the group discussion at the convocation will be tailored to address the strengths, weaknesses, hopes, and dreams of our diocese.

Our parish will be represented by a group of ten parishioners from all different ages groups at the regional meeting, and this same group will attend the Vision 20/20 convocation. This group, and similar groups formed at other parishes, are being called "evangelization teams." Therefore, these individuals will be in charged with bringing ideas about increasing evangelization efforts in our parish and throughout our diocese back to the parishes that they represent. Bishop Zinkula wants these teams to be a source of renewal in parishes, and then, in the summer of 2020, there will be a special event to celebrate the fruits of this year of renewal in the Diocese of Davenport.

The Parish Council will be working with our evangelization team to see where the insights of Vision 20/20 guide our parish. The Parish staff and other members of the parish have been doing a lot of work in regards to evangelization over the last year and a half, so I believe that OLV will be uniquely suited to integrate ideas from Vision 20/20 into the life of our parish. If you have any questions or concerns about the evangelization team, please reach out to Lisa Willows or myself. We are the two parish staff members who will be a part of our parish's evangelization team. We will be coordinating the team and making sure that information from this team gets back to parish leadership and communicated with the entire parish.

The Last Parish Center Update

The work on the Parish Center is now complete. Therefore, I will not be bringing up this topic again in my bulletin column! Amen! Alleluia! With the water mitigation work done in August and September and the completion of the bathrooms and kitchen last week, we now have full access to the facility once again. The parish was also blessed by many volunteers who helped over the last two weeks to clean and put the final touches on the Parish Center. The updated bathrooms and kitchen worked really well for the Women's CEW last weekend. Many of you will be able to see the updated facilities this weekend at the Sweetheart's Dinner or at the Men's CEW the following weekend. As I mentioned several times, these important updates would not have been possible without the generous support that we have received from parishioners like you because the reimbursement from insurance would not have covered the entire project. This parish is truly blessed by its parishioners and their commitment to address challenges that come our way!

Our Lady of Victory, thank you for your intercession on our behalf of our parish, and may your continued intercession help us to be your faithful disciples in the future!
