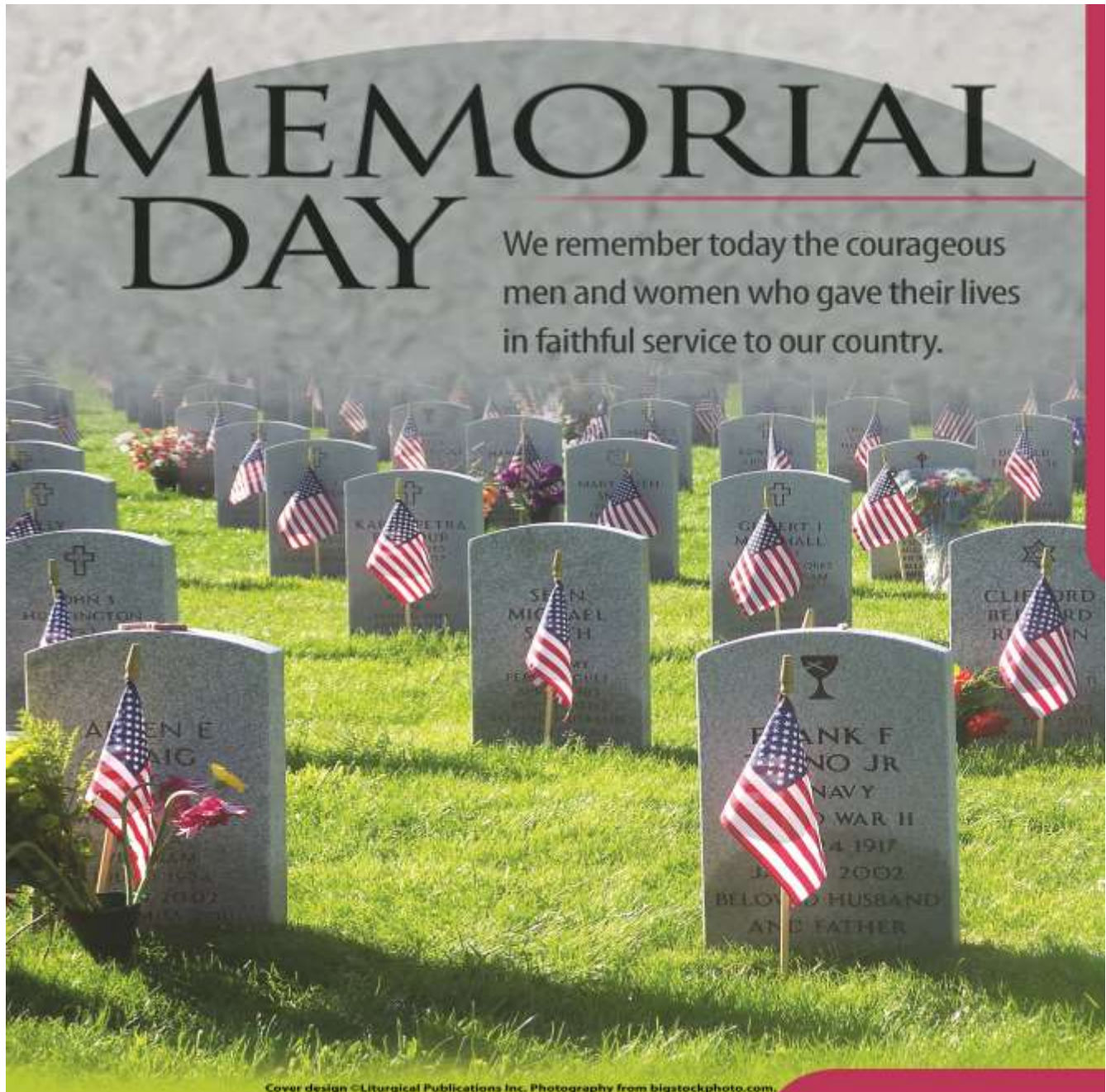

However, I hope that all of us will take a few minutes to remember why Memorial Day was first established here in the United States--to honor members of the military who have died in service of our country. The official time for silent remembrance is 3:00pm local time on Monday, May 27th. Whatever you do as a family or individual on Memorial Day, please take some time to remember the sacrifices made by our service members and their families.

2.) I want to recognize all of the high school seniors who will be graduating from high school this weekend and next weekend. Congratulations to these young women and men on this milestone in your life, and please be assured of our parish's continued thoughts and prayers for you in the future. Parents, I also want to congratulate you as well! Parenting is truly a blessing and challenge, so may God bless you abundantly for all you have done for your teenagers who are graduating from high school.

3.) As promised two weeks ago, I have an update about the OLV/JFK Gala. This annual event raised **\$32,000** for our community! Thank you to everyone who donated to the Gala, came to the event, and purchased items that evening!
