## A Message from Fr. Jake....

I want to personally thank everyone who helped make our Parish Picnic possible this last weekend! The rainy day did prevent outdoor activities, but I believe that everyone who attended the indoor picnic enjoyed the food, the fellowship, and the activities. If you have any feedback for the Parish Picnic committee, please make sure that you pass along this information to the parish office or a member of the Parish Council.

This weekend marks our parish's launch of the Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA). The goal for our parish this year is \$158,000. As you will see with the bulletin insert, Bishop Zinkula has chosen the theme of "Supporting the Vision" as the entire diocese continues to respond to the Vision 20/20 initiative. Here are some of the ways that our support of the ADA helps our parish and the entire diocese:

- **Priests and Deacons:** The ADA covers the expense for priestly and deacon formation as well as assisting priests with their retirement.
- **Catholic Schools:** The Office of Catholic Schools assists the pastors, principals and teachers of our diocese in maintaining an environment and curriculum that prepares our children to be leaders in our faith and in their future careers.
- **Confirmations:** The ADA makes it possible for Bishop Zinkula to go to parishes for Confirmation and other events throughout our twenty-two county diocese.
- **Annulments:** The Diocese of Davenport is one of the few dioceses in the U.S. that covers the expense of annulments so that there is no financial barrier to anyone seeking the healing that comes from this ministry.
- **Ministerial Resources for Parishes:** The ADA covers the administration costs for many diocesan programs, such as Ministry Formation, Stewardship, Social Action, Catholic Charities, and Youth Ministry and so much more.
- **Parish Financial Reviews:** The Diocesan Finance office assists parishes with financial reviews, human resources assistance, and annual parish Corporation meetings.
- **Archives:** The Chancery houses and maintains the sacramental records and other important parish records for each parish.

### September 29th is World Heart Day

Cardiovascular disease (CVD) is the world's number one killer today. But it doesn't need to be this way. By making just a few small changes to our lives, we can reduce our risk of heart disease and stroke as well as improving our quality of life and setting a good example for the next generation.

For my heart, for your heart, for all hearts:

- Promise to our families to cook and eat healthier.
- Promise to our children to exercise more and help them to be more active, to say no to smoking and help others to stop. (Tobacco use and exposure to secondhand smoke kill 6 million in the world a year. It is estimated to cause nearly 10% of CVD.)
- Promise to each other to give up smoking and lower our cholesterol. (Within two years of stopping smoking, the risk of CVD is substantially reduced.)

One small change could be having your blood pressure monitored regularly. The Wellness and Health team will be available next weekend after all Masses.

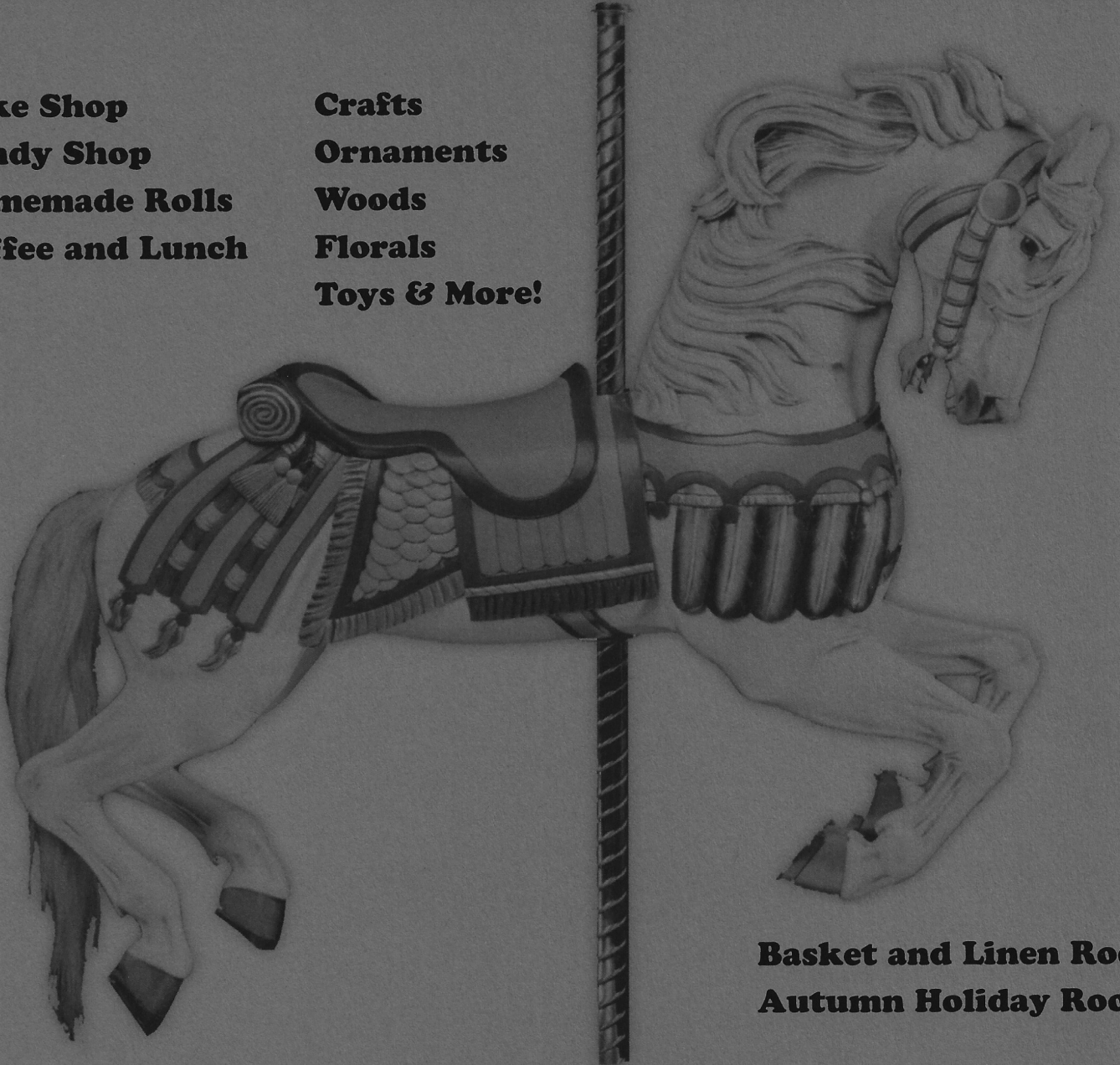

once said, “No one ever became poor by giving.”

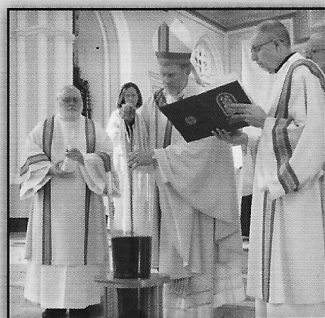
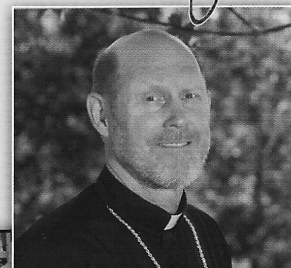

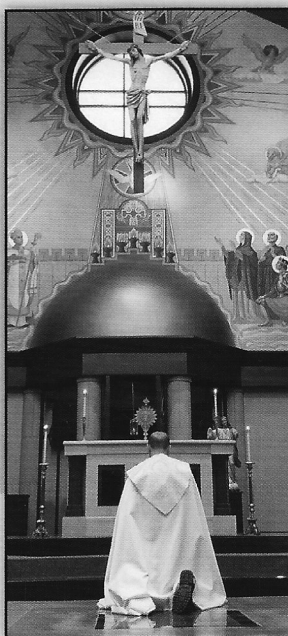
