You still have time-Get your flu shot. The best way to prevent influenza is by getting vaccinated each flu season. Most healthy adults are contagious 1 day prior to symptoms and 5-7 days after symptoms are present. Children and those with weakened immune systems can be contagious even longer.

Flu signs and symptoms include: Fatigue, muscle and body aches, coughing, sore throat, headache, runny nose or stuffy nose, fever or fever like symptoms and/or chills, vomiting and diarrhea (more common in children).
