I had the opportunity to attend the Heart to Heart -Community Education Series on November 19, 2019 at Unity Point Health Trinity. It was excellent and well worth the drive to Rock Island. According to cardiologist Dr. Bouyella Reddy, CVM, through a total plant diet and walking briskly (3.0 miles/hour) for 45 minutes/day can improve, most heart issues, including hypertension. (Please check with your doctor before starting any new exercise regimens.) It may be hard to follow Dr. Reddy's plan but, making some lifestyle changes will be beneficial. We will discuss those changes in later Wellness Corners.
