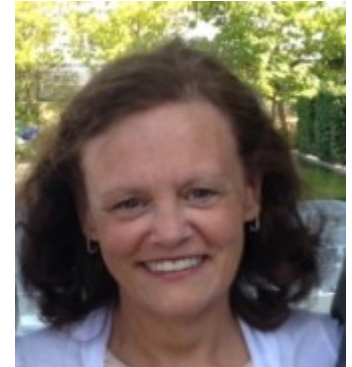


Our Lady of Victory Foundation's contribution to the parish, which is based on our fiscal year, ending December 2019 balance, where we reached the \$1,000,000 endowment goal, is \$55,000. This represents another record breaking return to the parish and school due to your faithful gifts and the Foundation's continued good stewardship of those gifts.

The \$55,000 is divided proportionally to the gifts given toward General Parish Education Fund, JFK Catholic School Staff Fund, JFK Catholic School Scholarship Fund, JFK Catholic School Facility Fund, Our Lady of Victory Facility Fund, and OLV Unspecified Fund.

The OLV Unspecified fund is the largest portion and we are pleased that this year's gift back to the parish for the OLV Unspecified Fund will be used in unison with the Cultivating our Future Campaign funds to complete the HVAC project next summer.

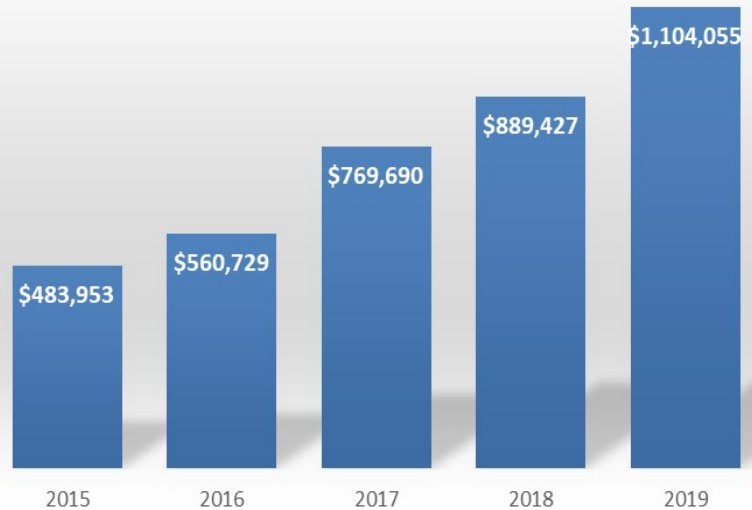
What began as a 3 year commitment has extended into an annual commitment due to our love for OLV and JFK.

Our daughters, Katherine & Caroline great foundations in life began here and we are very grateful for the gift of their Catholic education ~ there is a difference!

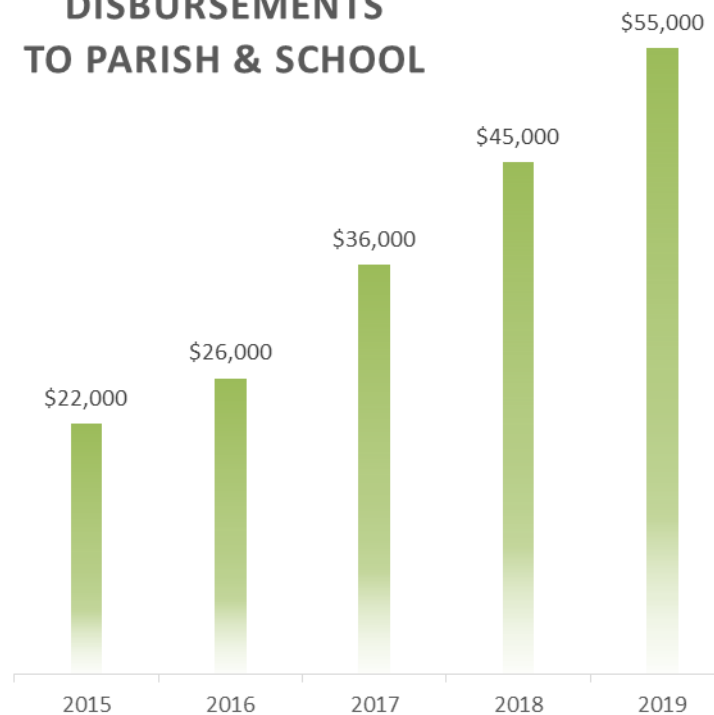

What is an Endowment?

An endowment is like a savings account. When a donor makes an endowment gift to the Foundation, the Foundation agrees not to spend the principal value of their gift and instead holds it in perpetuity. The gift is invested and only the earnings from the fund can be spent by the Foundation. The Foundation follows the guidelines set forth in the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act.

Legacy Campaign Reaches Goal in 2019

We are deeply grateful for the parishioners who joined the legacy campaign by making an outright gift or pledging a specific amount over a period of time by completing a letter of intent. Total intentions through 2019 represent more than \$286,700 in pledges, with over \$201,800 received. The Endowment Value chart on the previous page shows the \$1,000,000 goal has been reached! Thank you to everyone who has made a philanthropic investment in our parish and school.



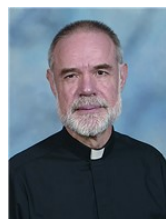

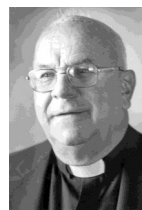

Board Member Spotlight: Meet the Nolans

Allow us to introduce and thank Board Member, Bob Nolan. Bob was a founding member of the Foundation in 1989 and Board president for its first 10 years. He dedicated 31 consecutive years of service to the Foundation. We are blessed to be the recipients of his many talents and leadership.

Bob grew up on a grain and livestock farm near Wyoming, Iowa. He shares "As I look back on those formative years on the farm, hard work was the norm. It gave me a great appreciation of nature and I have always known how blessed I am with that background of rural Iowa."

He attended Loras College and graduated from the U of Iowa College of Pharmacy in '71. He "was lucky to receive a commission as a pharmacist in the US Public Health Service & spent 3 years in a Marine Hospital in New Orleans."

He & Pat (who holds a Masters degree in Nursing) also grew up on a farm near DeWitt, married in 1972 & joined OLV in 1974. "Pat attended Catholic schools for 20 years." They have 3 children (who attended JFK & Assumption) and 8 grandchildren. "As a parent of JFK kids, I coached basketball and softball for many years. All of our grandchildren are attending Catholic Schools. What a blessing!"

Bob says: "Like so many other families, JFK and OLV had many ways to get involved in its community." He began his participation in our annual parish Fall Festival, Home & School (as VPs and then as Presidents). Pat & I also became very active in the OLV Choir for many years. Pat served on Parish Council and as President."

"We were both actively involved in the 1987 school expansion and the parish center. We both enjoyed our participation in Bible study groups over the years. I also helped serve monthly dinners from OLV at the Salvation Army," many meals prepared by Pat. Bob "made sure our daughters took turns serving the poor at those dinners. They talk about it today as helping them appreciate how we as Catholics and Christians need to support those less fortunate."

Bob spent "several years on the Parish Council's Christian Education Committee. We were always looking for ways to spark interest in our faith and what could we do to make it happen in a dynamic way. We brought several programs and Parish Retreats to OLV, introducing Christian Experience Weekends (CEW). I think the CEW program was a lightning rod that seemed to spark a center piece for sharing and growing our Catholic Christian Faith to others like no other Christian Education program has done to that extent and it continues!"

"In 1998, the interior of OLV was in great need of remodeling. I co-chaired that initiative with Terry Hester. We purchased new solid oak pews, a new tile floor, a new sound system, refurbished the altar area and repainted the interior of the church."

"After that, Fr. Kaska asked me to serve on the Finance Committee and I served as a lay director to OLV for 8 years. I represented the finance committee on the Parish Council for about 10 years and chaired the OLV Strategic Planning committee. We developed a new Mission Statement for the parish and the strategic plan served as a blueprint for parish planning & improvements including the Gathering Space and School Expansion in 2009-2012. Pat & I co-chaired the fund drive for that project with Randy and Kathy Peterson.

Whew! Bob worked tirelessly for OLV!

I asked Bob what does the OLV Foundation mean to him personally after many years of service on its board? What motivated he and Pat to participate so continuously?

"Reaching the one million dollar endowment goal is certainly at the top of my list! That is a great accomplishment for the Foundation. I am very pleased to have been on the board when we attained that goal.

However, I think one must keep in mind what the Foundation is not to answer this question appropriately. The Foundation is not a substitute for true Sacrificial Giving to the parish. It can be a supplement to Sacrificial Giving, but Sacrificial Giving is giving of time, talent or treasure for the immediate and present needs of our parish. With that in mind, giving to the Foundation should never create an impediment or present a hardship to consistent parish tithing!

The OLV Foundation since inception has always been sensitive to the immediate needs of the parish and school and attempted to work in the background with strategies for funding. Funding the Foundation has been a long-term process - sometimes frustratingly slow. I believe that has been an appropriate approach and has avoided any conflict of interest financially with other more pressing financial needs of the parish. Heavens, it took us over 31 years to reach one million dollars in our endowment! It didn't come from someone willing us a large farm or property or huge amount of appreciated stock or a large estate. It really came mostly from thousands of smaller cash donations plus many memorials and honorariums of present and former parishioners.

That is appropriate in my mind as it belongs to the entire OLV Parish family as it was sourced from many parish families. The Foundation is really an ideal tool for our parish and school to receive funds and legacies from present and former members of the parish with a goal to enhance the programs and finances of both the Church and JFK Catholic School. As our Foundation Brochure states: ***The purpose of the Foundation is to receive and invest funds donated so as to be a source of financial support to our parish and school.*** In other words, the givers to the Foundation endow it with funds and the Foundation establishes an endowment or permanent fund (investment) as a source of future income streams for the parish. That is working for OLV. The Foundation is now giving back over \$50,000 a year to the parish and school. I am most pleased with how the OLV Foundation was created for both the parish church and school and how it is presently funded."

Both Pat & Bob worked in the healthcare field for many years until their retirements in 2014. Bob and Pat recently relocated to Clive, Iowa, to be closer to their family. Bob strongly feels that "We will always consider OLV as our parish in our life so know that we will continue to be with OLV in spirit! We have been the ones blessed with the OLV family!"

OLV has been sincerely blessed too to have Pat & Bob Nolan as active members. Thank You, Bob & Pat, for all your endeavors to **Create Tomorrow's Parish Today** and to the entire Nolan Family!

Contribution levels for the Foundation provide a way to recognize exemplary leadership and service for those individuals the levels are named for, as well as recognize the donors who give at these leadership levels. During the recent Legacy Campaign for the Foundation, we honored OLV's previous pastors for their leadership and service to the parish, by naming giving levels in their honor. They are:

Msgr. James Parizek Victory Level - \$50,000
Fr. William Meyer Emeritus Level - \$25,000
Fr. William Kaska Heritage Level - \$12,500
Fr. Kenneth Martin Founders Level - \$5,000
300 Club Level - \$300 annually for 7 years

The Foundation's Board of Directors created the 300 Club in 2013. The focus of this decision was to generate enthusiasm for individuals by establishing an easy way to assist Creating Tomorrow's Parish Today. The concept is to contribute \$25 monthly each year (\$300) for 7 years to enable our organization to reach a \$1 million goal by 2021. 300 families x \$300 annually (about \$.82 daily) enhances OLV's opportunity to surpass this lofty milestone. We successfully met this \$1 million level before our projections in December 2019 because of everyone's continued support. Much of your accomplishments are the result of the 300 Club membership and the Legacy Campaign wherein many 300 Club members renewed their pledge. Many donors made additional "stretch" commitments.

The 300 Club grew annually and we now have over 100 regular members. It is the backbone, the true lifeline of our Foundation. As founding member, Mary Ann Otte, (who passed away due to COVID-19 in March 2020) highlighted in last year's annual report, "one rain drop at a time." Her belief that "just as it takes many rain drops to fill a jar, you could be the one rain drop to overflow the jar." This steadfast approach illustrates how easy it is to increase our funds with more participants. She was a superb example of a typical person who made a difference!

We welcome anyone's gifts and contribution regardless of their amount or whatever level in which one chooses to participate. Please consider discussing how easy it is to become involved with your family and friends. One can give in a variety of ways: online electronically, monthly using parish envelopes, special times for memorials at time of passing or honorarium for someone's birthday, anniversary, or other celebration. Charitable IRA rollovers are ways to share your required minimum distributions with the Foundation. Future bequest gifts planned through your estate are welcome in the Legacy Club. The Board of Directors unanimously agreed at its 2020 annual meeting to note the 300 Club as the **Mary Ann Otte 300 Club** in her honor through June 2021. She inspired us for over 31 years as a board member with her dedication, loyalty and recommendations that she shared so generously with our fortunate parish.
