The most important things you can do to help prevent cervical cancer are to get vaccinated against HPV, have regular screening tests, and go back to the doctor if your screening test results are not normal.

Encourage the women in your life to make their health a priority and be an example by getting your annual wellness exam.



Adult Bible Study
Lent is an important season in the Church's liturgical year. Oftentimes we lose sight of the point of this season because we get caught up in ourselves-and about how hard it is to fast, or how bad we are at fasting—and we end up just waiting for the season to be over at Easter. Because of this, we sometimes arrive at Easter no different than we were on Ash Wednesday.


