Registration Process for Pre-School and Daycare

Parishioners and JFK community members' registration begins

February 7, 2022 7:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

- 1) Complete a student information sheet and home language survey
- 2) Provide a copy of a birth certificate (or a copy can be made at school)
- 3) Pay the \$150 registration fee, discounted to \$100 for parishioners and current JFK/Guardian Angel families if registered before May 1, 2022
- 4) Complete a payment contract
- 5) Physical and proof of immunizations required before classes begin in August

Tuition Assistance

- 75%-85% of families who apply for financial assistance typically receive assistance
- A family's "financial need" is determined through a formula that considers the family's total Catholic school education bill, family size, gross and net incomes, and other factors.
