Growing Our Faith Capital Campaign WE DID IT. THANK YOU!

What an amazing five years! In early 2008 we began a capital campaign with the goal of raising \$2.4 million for construction of a gathering space at church, office and classroom additions at our school, and completion of campus improvements. In December 2011, with the support of over 800 donors, we celebrated a major milestone with the dedication of our newly constructed spaces.

Our beautiful facilities, along with our expanding programs of excellence, continue to be supported by many generous parishioners and friends. As of September 30, 2013 our mortgage balance stood at \$269,000. We have been able to substantially reduce our debt with surplus funds generated over the last four fiscal years, a large number of memorial and estate gifts directed toward this project, and a substantial grant from Scott County Regional Authority (SCRA) for construction of the music room at John F. Kennedy Catholic School.

Final gifts to the *Growing Our Faith* campaign are scheduled to be received by December 31. After this date we will no longer actively follow up with pledges and the green GOF envelope will disappear from the monthly offering packet. Those who want to help eliminate the remaining mortgage balance are invited to use **the yellow "Building & Development" envelope, which will** continue to be included in the monthly packet. Gifts to this fund will be used for long-term campus improvements and debt reduction.

What has happened here is beyond our wildest dreams and truly a historic accomplishment. We pray that each donor, parishioner and school family takes pride in this extraordinary accomplishment and knows how grateful we are for their continued commitment to fostering a vibrant Catholic community.


Thanks to the generosity of our parishioners and prudent management of resources, we ended the fiscal year with income outpacing expenses by more than \$100,000. Surplus funds were used to reduce the mortgage. To eliminate the debt as rapidly as possible, future budgets will reflect accelerated payments on the principle of approximately \$60,000 annually.
