

Area or Program: **Small Group Ministry**

Role Title: **Small Group Facilitator**

Helpful Skills:

Charisms for Pastoring, Prophecy, Wisdom, Evangelization, Teaching, and/or Mercy
Being a friendly, personable, and invitational person.
Able to lead a conversation and facilitate a discussion.
Able to engage in active listening and ask leading questions.
Comfortable with silence!

Duties and Responsibilities:

Manage whatever small group materials are being used, ie Formed.org, Ydisciple, Bible study materials, current events, daily mass readings, etc.
Coordinate with your group's assigned Host from the Hospitality team.
Engage in relational ministry with teens first and foremost. You don't need to have all the answers (or even, necessarily, any answers), but you always have to be present and care!
Facilitate discussions at least once a month, preferably once a week.

Training/Support: VIRTUS, Called and Gifted, Facilitation training, Small group support FOR small group facilitators.

Supervision/Accountability: Report to Small Group Coordinator

Benefits: This is the meat and potatoes of ministry - not just to teens, but to all people. This is where relationships are fostered and discipleship really digs in. This is where you grow closer to the teens, and really show them how to be a mature Christian disciple, while still having fun. It's also an opportunity to exercise a broad array of spiritual gifts, and grow deeper in your own faith as you are challenged and stretched by the questions of the day.

Length of Commitment: Once per week/month for one year (Renewable).
